

FORESTS BOG ARE HOME TO BOOLD'S TERRESTRIAL BODIVERSITY

To preserve species, nothing is more effective than protecting their habitat. Did you know that there are an estimated 8 to 12 million species living on Earth (excluding bacteria), and that only 2 million have been catalogued to date? We estimate that no fewer than 1 million species are threatened with extinction this century, primarily due to habitat loss.

Tropical forests are home to most of the Earth's biodiversity. They are rich and complex ecosystems, the fruit of a long evolution, impossible to reconstitute simply by planting trees. Part of this biodiversity will disappear forever if we continue to nibble away at the last remaining tropical forest anctuaries.

FORESTS: POLLINATION RESERVES

Preserving the forest also means saving the pollinators crucial to agriculture: domestic and wild bees, butterflies, ladybugs, insects, reptiles, hummingbirds and bats... **Over 70% of the world's food** crops benefit from animal pollination, **as do 90% of wild flowering plants.**

Thousands of species have already disappeared before they were even recorded, and wild vertebrate populations have fallen by 69% since 1970.

of freshwater resources come from forested catchment areas, with the forest acting as a giant water purifier.
